








Scholastic Academy of Excellence adheres to the 6ft apart rule











Rotunda on our main floor from the entrance way







Classroom Configuration 1st Grade Classroom








2nd floor wing houses 4th grade, 5th grade 6th grade Self-contained ISP4-6, ENL classroom and 2nd grade







