<u>Lining Up the Graduates</u>: magnet classes will be called outside over the PA. Each magnet will line up outside the building along the Briggs Avenue side of the school building. Students will be called by magnet. The order of the magnets was selected randomly:

When a student's name is called, they will receive their decorative diploma cover from Dr. Quezada, and then proceed down the front lot. They will receive several parting gifts crafted especially for the SHS Class of 2021 to commemorate their achievements and for making it to this special day. They will also receive an envelope that contains their actual diploma, as well as several certificates of recognition. Step and repeat batters will also be set up along the front lot for photo opportunities. Students will then exit the front lot by the baseball field.

<u>Guests</u>: guests are invited to watch the ceremony from the front lawn and sidewalk along Palmer Road. We ask that all guests follow social distancing guidelines.

<u>VIP Guests</u>: each student was given two VIP guest tickets on lanyards. When these guests arrive, they should proceed to the front lot near the traffic circle. Each magnet has a waiting area, designated by a sign with the magnet name on it. Before each magnet is called up, we invite the VIP guests to an area closer to the where students will receive their diploma.

After all students from a magnet have been called, we ask that the VIP guests join the other guests along the sidewalk, to ensure that all that have a ticket have an opportunity at this experience.
