## Reach


- Academically challenging you may not quite fit the college's academic profile

# Safety


- Schools where you are almost certain to be admitted

## COLLEGE APPLICATION DEADLINES




- Let us know if you are applying early to any program







#### Letters of Recommendation

- 2 CORE Teachers
- 1 School Counselor (check with college)
- Request in advance teachers may require resume/brag sheet








## **STEP 2: GATHER YOUR** INFORMATION **AND SUBMIT ONLINE**

# WHO'S MY PARENT WHEN I FILL OUT MY FAFSA?

Dependent students are required to report parent information on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). For reporting purposes, "PARENT" means your legal (biological or adoptive) parent or stepparent, or a person that the state has determined to be your legal parent.

Use this guide to figure out which parent's information to include (depending on your family situation).

If you're not sure whom to report as a parent, you can visit StudentAid.ed.gov/fafsa/filling-out/parent-info or call 800-4-FED-AID (800-433-3243).

If you're not sure whether you are a dependent student, go to StudentAid.gov/fafsa/filling-out/dependency

# PROCESSING THE FAFSA®

After you submit your FAFSA, your information will be sent to the colleges and/or career schools you listed on the form.

#### **PROCESS TIMELINE**

You'll receive an e-mail within a few days, letting you know your FAFSA was processed.

Your college or career school might request additional information from you. Make sure you respond by any deadlines.

#### FIRST-TIME APPLICANTS

You'll receive an aid offer from each college or career school you applied to and listed on your FAFSA, stating the amount of aid you could receive at the school.

Review and compare your offers, and decide which school to attend based on the school's net cost and how well the school suits your needs.

#### **RENEWAL APPLICANTS**

You'll receive an aid offer from your school stating the amount of aid you could receive at the school.


#### **RECEIVING FINANCIAL AID**

Formally accept the school's aid offer - and remember, if you're offered student loans, borrow only as much as you really need.

Your school will handle your aid. Ask the financial aid office when and how your aid will be paid out, what it'll cover, and how much (if any) money will come directly to you once tuition and fees are paid.

# FOLLOWING UP ON THE FASFA

- FAFSA follow-up is available at <a href="http://www.fafsa.ed.gov">http://www.fafsa.ed.gov</a>. This site provides resources for managing your FAFSA, including allowing you to:
- 1. Add or delete a school code
- 2. Check the status of a submitted FAFSA or print signature page which is available one week after submission if you used your FSA ID to sign your application, and two to three weeks after submission if you printed, signed and mailed a signature page.
- 3. View and print your Student Aid Report (SAR)
- Make corrections to a processed FAFSA

# FOLLOWING UP ON THE FASFA

#### **Apply for Aid Each Year You're in College**

 Remember, you need to complete the FAFSA not just once, but every year you plan to attend school. If you filled out a FAFSA the year before, you can probably use the shorter Renewal FAFSA and TAP application.

#### **Beware!**

- Watch out for organizations that charge a fee to submit your application. You can fill it out for free.
- Be wary of organizations that charge a fee to find you money for school. Some are legitimate and some are scams.
- Generally, any help that you pay for can be received free from your college financial aid office and HESC.
