Municipal Housing Authority Taps Yonkers Arts to Improve Quality of Life for Residents through Art Installations at Multiple Locations.

Municipal Housing Authority of Yonkers (MHACY) and the City of Yonkers have engaged Yonkers Arts to enhance and improve the quality of life for their residents and surrounding neighborhoods in more than 15 locations.

Art, in all its forms, is a language that speaks to the soul, stimulates the mind and warms the heart, says Ray Wilcox; Executive Director of Yonkers Arts. For over a decade, Yonkers Arts has been dedicated to promoting local art, artists, and cultural organizations throughout the City of Yonkers.

The purpose of the project; according to Adam Shultz, co-president of Yonkers Arts, is to place great art and develop integrated aesthetic solutions inside and outside of MHACY senior living, senior assisted, low income family residential, and townhouses.

The project will develop in phases across 2021 and possibly beyond.


