

**MINUTES OF
YONKERS CITY SCHOOL LIBRARY SYSTEM COUNCIL MEETING
November 29, 2023**

Reports:

Membership: (Carol Westphal)

- Jim Riley reported membership expired on September 30, 2023 for Nicole Taylor-Wernham. She unanimously agreed to serve another term.
- The 2023-2024 Council Members List was updated to reflect membership expiration dates.

Professional Development:

• Library Services:

- October 23, 2023 – Carol Westphal attended a Zoom meeting with Christa Taylor to discuss the different libraries offered to our students and staff on SORA.
- October 24, 2023 – LMS attended a Zoom meeting facilitated by Crystal Ballad from Teaching Books.
- October 25, 2023 – Dr. Palmer led a Professional Development meeting for the LMS at Yonkers Montessori Academy. Various topics were covered.
- November 27, 2023 – Jim Riley presented Teaching Books to the Saunders HS English Department.
- Through the Smart Start Grant Jim Riley and students from Saunders HS visited the Croton Aqueduct. They used drones to prepare a Virtual Tour of the area.
- Jim Riley and Carol Westphal continue to attend the Dept. Rep. PLC's.
- Some of the Library staff will participate in Job Shadowing a certified SLMS.

Yonkers Public Library Report:

- YPL received the Joseph Schubert Excellence Award for their Summer Reading Buddies Program, which trains volunteer mentors to read with children weekly.
- Nancy Moron, President of the YPL Board of Trustees, received the Velma K. Moore award for her exemplary contributions to library services.
- YPL received a \$25,000 grant from the NY State Council on the Arts (NYSCA) for Arts programming.
- All YPL branches have Winter Wonderland programs scheduled. Program details are available online.
- YPL invites all readers to join the Winter Reading Warm-up Challenge! The program runs from January 1, 2024-March 15, 2024. All readers will use Beanstack to log their books. For each book a patron logs they will be entered into a raffle for an Amazon gift card.
- Z Baird received the Heroes of Education Award.

- YPL suggested YPS meet through Zoom to discuss and plan Summer Reading 2024. Several meetings have been planned.

Library Services Report:

- Dr. Palmer requested the number of library applications sent from YPS for YPL cards. Jesse Montero will work on this data.
- Dr. Palmer will continue to focus on Professional Development for the LMS.
- The YPS School Choice Fair will take place on Saturday, December 2, 2023 at Saunders HS. Dr. Palmer and Carol Westphal will represent Library Services.
- Dr. Palmer will work with Saunders HS students to develop a new logo for Library Services.
