Professional Development:

• Library Services:

- September 6, 2023 – Superintendent’s Conference Day. All the Library Media Specialist participated in the following workshops: Teaching Books, Gale, Yonkers Public Library offerings at all three branches and PebbleGo.
- Some of the Library staff will participate in Job Shadowing a certified SLMS.
- Dr. Palmer would like to have a monthly Library meeting for Library staff.

Yonkers Public Library Report:

- The Summer Reading Buddy Program was held at the Riverfront Library.
- September is Library Card Sign-up Month. Library Applications have been sent to all schools. Dr. Palmer will resend the application for staff to apply for an educator’s card. Library cards are also available in Spanish.
- The theme for Banned Books Week 2023 is: “Let Freedom Read.” To celebrate the freedom to read all three branches will highlight this theme from October 1st – October 7th. Patrons could print Banned Book Bingo cards and view a list of books on the cards.
- Many in-person and online programs were held at all three branches for Hispanic Heritage Month.
- YPL will host events at all three branches for Italian Heritage Month, as well as Native American Heritage Month.

- The YPL received State Aid for a Library Construction Grant. This funding will support construction work at the Crestwood Library and the Grinton I. Will Library.
- YPL released a limited-edition Library Card in recognition of the 50th Anniversary of Hip Hop. A new card will be released each year.
