

Here is a quick example of a P.E.E.L. paragraph.

What was the main problem that Elizabeth I faced when she came to the throne of England in 1558?

It can be argued that the main problem Elizabeth I of England faced when she came to the throne was the problem of marriage. Firstly, Elizabeth was expected to marry and produce an heir to the throne. If she did not get married she would not have a child and the Tudor family reign would end. However, if she got married, Elizabeth's husband could take over her throne and Elizabeth would lose her power. This meant that Elizabeth was in a very difficult position and would have to make a hard choice either way. We can therefore see that Elizabeth's main problem in 1558 was whether to get married at all.

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
