Yonkers Public Library Report: (Jesse Montero and Z Baird)

- YPL has returned to contact free pickup. A decision will be made on 12.4.2020 as to whether they will reopen. If YPL chooses to reopen there will be changes due to the need for unnecessary risk: no computer service and no chairs at reading tables.
- Virtual services remain available as well as holds, calls for assistance and over 1000 services via virtual access since March 2020.
- Jesse Montero thanked Tracey Wong for making the link live to the YPS Teachers for their new YPL card. The new card is more about digital access. This is a new policy and the partnership is appreciated.
- Susan Thaler expanded upon the collaboration between the Yonkers Public Schools and the Yonkers Public Libraries.

Library Services Report:

- Dr. Andrea Cordett spoke about the need for cultural development of the Yonkers Public Schools library collections.
- Tracey Wong encouraged the Librarians to create Donor's Choose accounts. Jim Riley has created an account to obtain 3D pens. Nicole Taylor-Wernham created an account to obtain a printer for Dodson and will create another to obtain a printer for Fermi. Carol Westphal has created an account for YMA to obtain 3D Pens.
