


## LOG INTO YOUR STUDENT ACCOUNT:

1. Go to ~~[www.castlelearning.com](http://www.castlelearning.com)~~ *clever.com/in/yonkers*
2. Click **Log In**
3. Type your Castle Learning ID in the **ID/Email** field.  
Call 800-345-7606 if unsure of your Castle Learning ID or Password  
**NOTE:** Email cannot be used until you have logged in and set up your profile with your email address.
4. Type your password into the **Password** field and click **Sign In**. You will need to Re-type Your Password the first time in to set your own password.  
**NOTE:** Use your school or teacher assigned password or leave it blank if not provided.
5. Type in **Your Email Address** if you have one.
6. Click **Submit**

## SELECT A REGENTS REVIEW:

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1. Click on **Self Study**
  2. Scroll down and click on the **Regents Exams** icon
  3. Choose the content (Math, Science, Social Studies, English Language Arts, Spanish, French)
  4. Click on the course
  5. Click on the exam to start the Regents review



**NOTE:** If you do not complete the review, use the X in the upper left corner and then choose **Exit and Save**. You will find your incomplete review under **Incomplete Assignments, Self Study**.

## INCOMPLETE REVIEW: (If you didn't get a chance to complete the Regents Review you started)

1. Click on **Incomplete Assignments**
2. Click on **Self Study**

## REPORTS: (View your results)

1. Click on **Reports**
2. Choose **Completed Assignments, Self Study Assignments**
3. Use the 3 dots next to "for additional options" to sort  
OR  
Use the Search bar to look for an assignment
4. Click on the assignment to create the report

## PRACTICE SPECIFIC AREAS OF WEAKNESS:

1. Click on **Self Study**
2. Above the course, click on **Rocket Mode** and use that to study in your specific areas that need work - be sure to choose a grade 9-12 OR change to **Expert Mode**
  - o Choose **Course**
  - o Choose **Grade Level, High School** (after selecting a grade group, click on x in upper left corner of that box to get out of selection panel) – you will have to select a lower grade level to practice basic **Math Skills**
  - o Choose **Topics, Reading Sets or Math Skills**
