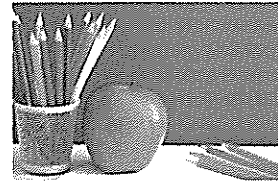


Mrs. Pezzulo's School Supply List

Primary Grades: (1st, 2nd, & 3rd)



*** WRITE YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON ALL SUPPLIES WITH A BLACK SHARPIE PERMANENT MARKER.**

***(NO PAPER FOLDERS PLEASE). PLEASE LOOK BELOW WHAT SUPPLIES ARE NEEDED.**

- Grade 1 : 1 plastic red folder
- Grade 2: 1 plastic blue folder
- Grade 3: 1 plastic green folder

- 1 pack of Crayola colored pencils
- 1 clear ruler (any color). *Must have inches and centimeters.
- 1 hand-held, good quality, pencil sharpener.
- 3 Elmer's Glue sticks
- 1 box of yellow #2 pre-sharpened pencils.
- 1 container of antibacterial wipes
- 1 box of tissues – We will notify you, during winter months, if more is needed.
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 set of headphones.
- 1 plastic pencil case, to hold school supplies.
- Grades 2 & 3 only: Please send in 6 marble notebooks (Any color is acceptable). Please write your child's name on each composition book.
- 1 set of Crayola Crayons (24 pack)

Grade 1 only: Parents, please note that, the new students coming up to 1st grade, haven't had sufficient time to learn how to write in a regular a marble notebook. Most students, may not have the fine motor skills that are required for 1st grade. First graders need to learn the formation of letters, to write smaller, and they also need perforated guidance lines to lead them. It is essential that they develop their fine motor writing skills, learn how to hold a pencil with a "Pincer Grasp." The pincer grasp is important because it allows children to develop self-care tasks like buttoning, zipping, and lacing. It is important for future skills like handwriting. **If you are interested in purchasing the composition books, from me, the cost is \$5.00 for 5 books or you can purchase them yourselves on Amazon.com. They notebooks say grade 3, but I use them for the 1st grade because the lines are smaller.** They are paperback and have a red & white marble design on the cover.
